



Make a World of Difference Award

Each Bethel in Missouri is encouraged to help our world. Special recognition will be given at Mini Session and at Grand Session for each term that the Bethel documents the ways in which they have made difference.

One activity per term in each of the following categories will qualify the Bethel for recognition:

1. Make a difference at your meeting place:

- a. Plant flowers, trees, bushes or other landscaping improvement to the area around your Temple or meeting place.
- b. Clean up the lawn, mow, trim or pick up trash surrounding the building.
- c. Clean the inside in a special way (not normal cleaning your Bethel is expected to do): Scrub baseboards or floors, paint, clean kitchen equipment, etc.
- d. Serve refreshments or entertain in an out of the ordinary way for another group that meets in the same place.
- e. Find another way to help at your meeting place.

2. Make a difference in your community:

- a. Pick up trash along a roadway or in a park.
- b. Plant flowers or bring potted plants to a hospital, nursing home, school or retirement center.
- c. Help with Operation Clean Stream or a Park Improvement Day.
- d. Volunteer for a community event—not as a fund raiser
- e. Find another way to be helpful to your community.

3. Make a difference in our world:

- a. Participate in or donate time to work for a charity event that helps others such as Relay for Life, Race for the Cure, Ring Bell for Salvation Army, etc.
- b. Collect for a charity such as a food pantry, local assistance place— EX: door to door—trick or treat for UNICEF, Trick or Treat for Canned goods, have a collection sight at a Bethel event (like a car wash or bakesale), etc.
- c. Donate time to an aid group—Habitat for Humanity, work at a soup kitchen, volunteer at a nursing home or hospital, assist a local church with a mission project.
- d. Find another way to help our world.

How to be recognized:

To be recognized for making a difference each Bethel must do an activity in each of the three categories each term. A scrapbook page of pictures of the daughters doing the activity must be submitted on an 8 ½ X 11 sheet, preferably—only one page is needed and can have three pictures, one of each category **or** be creative and do a small book with three or more pages documenting the efforts and enthusiasm of the group. Be sure to include captions or a narration of the event. Include when, where, how many members and other important information. Don't forget to identify the Bethel and its location!

The picture pages will not be returned, but will be kept in a promotional binder for display at promotional booths, such as at Grand Lodge, etc. Let's make sure EVERY Missouri Bethel is represented!
